Immunizations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hepatitis (preventative)</li> <li>Tetanus</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hepatitis (following exposure)</li> <li>Rabies (following injury)</li> </ul>
Cleaning or soaking wounds	Always first aid	N/A
