

Annual Public Forum Guidelines for Public Comment

AUDIO AND/OR VIDEO RECORDING OF THE COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE SYSTEM ANNUAL PUBLIC FORUM IS NOT PERMITTED, WITHOUT THE EXPRESS WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE CHAIRPERSON.

- 1. Any individual who desires to provide public comment on any agenda item, must provide their name and organization on the sign-in sheet and the item(s) you would like to address. If you are not affiliated with an organization, write 'none' in that section.
- 2. Public comments will only be permitted during the General Public Comment Period on the meeting agenda.
- 3. The Chairperson will recognize the person(s) requesting the opportunity to make public comment only during the General Public Comment Period.
- 4. Each person who signed up to speak will be introduced by the Chairperson and given up to three (3) minutes to speak on one agenda item or on a combination of agenda items.
- 5. The Board of Directors requests that groups or organizations be represented by a single spokesperson. Duplicate or repetitive commenters will not be permitted.
- 6. Board members may ask questions of any individual addressing the Board of Directors, but should not debate or argue issues during the General Public Comment Period.
- 7. All questions will be directed at the Chairperson. The Board of Directors is not required to respond to questions asked during the General Public Comment Period.
- 8. Individuals may only provide comments on the following topics: (1) Community Healthcare System's performance in the previous year; (2) pricing of health services provided at Community Healthcare System; and (3) contributions made by Community Healthcare System to the community.
- 9. Public comments regarding personal issues, as determined by the Chairperson, will not be addressed in any manner.
- 10. If at any time during the meeting conditions pose a public safety concern, the Chairperson may deem it necessary to request the removal of the individual(s) causing the disruption or disorderly conduct and/or may adjourn the meeting without advance notice.
